As an organization of predominantly African American women, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is uniquely positioned to impact the families and communities we serve. Committing our bodies to physical and Mental Health is now our signature call to action. This initiative addresses the challenges of living holistic and healthy lives. Our organization makes PowerUp Journey to Wellness come to life through programs such as DeltaFit: Fit, Fine & Heart Healthy and SPAC's Change4Life HealthExpo.

St. Petersburg Alumnae Chapter conducts projects and programs designed to address the need for excellence in education and to confront the problems of African American women in all age groups. For years, the organization has provided stellar youth initiatives including programs that focus on African American young men who are at risk.

In addition to these programs, the organization is committed to giving multiple scholarships to Pinellas County students each year. In 2021, our chapter invested nearly \$50,000 in our community through our scholarships and community service programs.



Today, low voter turnout statistics highlight the need to continue to identify ways to include opportunities for all citizens to exercise their voting power. The Social Action Committee in St. Petersburg has received awards at the state level for our Souls to the Polls initiatives and the renaming of a portion of Interstate 375 in honor of Charter Member C.
